


## A little about Me & SMR Architects ...


- 50 strong, formed in 2014, with our roots extending back to 1991.

- Create more mixed-use spaces
- Deliver better architecture people understand logistics needs to be on our doorsteps
- · Look at under utilised space and how we can better re-purpose it.
- Think smarter about combined activities can similar activities share similar space:
  - Dark kitchens and food deliveries
  - On-demand grocery services
  - Mirco mobility parcel deliver
- More commercially viable method of getting last mile into the city centres as combined units provide a different rent model.
